Additional member on the Sanitary Board.

NO. 1 OF 1890.

An Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, to appoint an additional member on the Sanitary Board. Title.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Hongkong, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding any provisions of *The Public Health Ordinance, 1887*, to the contrary, it shall be lawful for the Governor to nominate and appoint OSBERT CHADWICK, Esquire, C.M.G., to be an additional member of the Sanitary Board as constituted by or under *The Public Health Ordinance, 1887*.

Power to Governor to appoint an additional member on the Sanitary Board.

2. When made such appointment shall be notified in the *Gazette*, and thereupon the said OSBERT CHADWICK shall have the like powers and authorities, privileges and immunities as by the said Ordinance are vested or granted in or to the present members of the said Board.

Appointment to be gazetted.
