ORDINANCE NO. 29 of 1937. (PLEASURE GROUNDS  
AND BATHING PLACES).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph 4 of the Regulations in the Second Schedule to the Pleasure Grounds and Bathing Places Regulation Ordinance, 1936, His Excellency the Governor hereby amends the Table of Recreation Grounds in the before-mentioned Second Schedule as follows:—

**AMENDMENT.**

The Government Notification No. 636 published in the Gazette of 29th November, 1946, (which contains the Table of Recreation Grounds) is amended by adding, at the end of the list of Recreation Grounds, under the sub-heading "King's Park Recreation Ground", the following entries in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 thereof respectively:—
