ORDINANCE NO. 29 of 1935. (PLEASURE GROUNDS AND BATHING PLACES).

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph 4 of the Regulations in the Second Schedule to the Pleasure Grounds and Bathing Places Regulation Ordinance, 1936, His Excellency the Governor hereby amends the Table of Recreation Grounds in the before-mentioned Second Schedule as follows:—

AMENDMENT.

Government Notification No. 636 published in the Gazette of 29th November, 1946, (which contains the Table of Recreation Grounds) is amended by adding; at the end of the list of Recreation Grounds, under the sub-heading "King's Park Recreation Ground", the following entries in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 thereof respectively:—
